



MURRUMBEENA PRIMARY SCHOOL
LOCAL EXCURSION CONSENT FORM,
2022 FOR YEARS P-6

In 2022, Murrumbeena Primary School may take students outside of school grounds to undertake educational activities in the local area.

The purpose of this form is to obtain parent/carer consent for local excursions during 2022

This form does NOT provide consent for excursions that go beyond the local area.

Local excursions

Local excursions are excursions to locations within walking distance of the school and do not involve 'Adventure Activities'. Local excursions that your child may participate in throughout 2021 could include:

- A walk to around the block
- Walk to the local shops (Neerim Road)
- Walks to our local parks (Boyd Park from Dandenong Road to Hughesdale Station)
- The park on the corner of Neerim and Tucker Roads (an extension of Boyd Park).

Emergency Evacuation Point (including for drills)

This form will also include walks to the 9th Caulfield (Murrumbeena) Scout Hall (20 Ricourt Ave, Murrumbeena). This Scout hall is our designated 'off site emergency assembly point.' The school will advise parents via Compass prior to a drill if we intend to conduct an 'off site' drill.

- The Murrumbeena Scout Hall – 20 Ricourt Ave. (9th Caulfield (Murrumbeena) Scout Hall).

Notification of Local Excursions

Murrumbeena Primary School will NOT seek further consent from you before local excursions take place. However, we will provide advance notice to parents/carers of upcoming local excursions through Compass.

For local excursions that occur on a recurring basis, Murrumbeena Primary School will notify parents/carers once only prior to the commencement of the recurring event, eg; weekly sports lessons at the local park.

Please keep the school informed of any updated contact details to ensure you receive these notifications.

First Aid and Medical Attention

Where necessary, school staff will administer first aid. School staff will also seek emergency medical attention for your child if it is considered reasonably necessary. Any costs associated with student injury rest with parents/carers unless the Department of Education and Training is liable in negligence (liability is not automatic).

Accident and Ambulance Cover

The Department of Education and Training does not provide student accident insurance or ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain this cover, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations.
